Unlike other festivals in the church's liturgical calendar, **Trinity Sunday** centres on a doctrine of the church, rather than an event. On this day we celebrate the unfathomable mystery of God's being, which we speak of as Trinity. May this be a day of adoration and praise of the God who is from eternity to eternity, beyond our sight and comprehension, and who yet comes to us, and reveals himself to us.

This is **Refugee Week**, connecting with World Refugee Day which is Friday. The week celebrates the contributions of people seeking sanctuary, and challenges negative stereotypes.

The work of **Samuel and Henrietta Barnett**, remembered on Tuesday, is a reminder that much we take for granted in terms of social care was the result of many years of campaigning work by those who, like Henrietta Barnett, refused to let the status quo go unchallenged.

Thursday is **Corpus Christi**. Give thanks for the institution of Holy Communion, in which our Lord promises to be present among us as we meet in his name, and break the bread he blesses.

Friday is the **Visitation**, and it is as Mary visits her kinswoman Elizabeth that she speaks the words we call the Magnificat.

The **Summer Solstice** falls on Saturday: give thanks for the rhythm of the seasons, and the way in which the natural world can speak to us of the wonder and majesty of its Creator.

Saturday is also **World Music Day**: give thanks for the diverse and vibrant world of music, for all who write and compose, and especially for all who help children and young people to develop skills or just to enjoy different forms of music.

World MND Day is marked on Saturday. Pray for all who live with Motor Neurone Disease and for their support, and for continued research.
